


We are going to the Busselton Jetty Underwater Observatory

We can go on a tour inside and look through big windows under the sea.






It might be a little dark, but I will be safe.



I will see coral, fish and other sea creatures.






We will be greeted by a tour guide who will tell us the rules.

We will follow the guide down the stairs.




We will stop and listen at the different platforms as they tell us about what we can see at each level.
